<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Medical Corps personnel are Rated members of the Central Aid Agency who are tasked with providing medical and first aid services to C.A.A. personnel and the public. Trained in disaster response, these personnel are deployed to incidents to provide medical support to C.A.A. emergency response operations.</li> </ul>				
TYPE OF ASSIGNMENT				
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This is a <b>Primary Duty Assignment</b>. Personnel assigned to Med Corps carry out the related duties as their main role within the Central Aid Agency.</li> </ul>				
DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES				
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Respond to emergency and disaster medical situations to provide first aid, medical services, and patient care.</li> <li>• Deploy to provide medical support to C.A.A. operations.</li> <li>• Conduct patient/casualty management and care.</li> <li>• Establish and operate medical treatment and casualty collection sites when deployed.</li> <li>• Assist with disaster mortuary operations, as needed.</li> <li>• Assist partner agencies with medical operations or support, as needed.</li> <li>• Assist with disaster mitigation and preparedness.</li> <li>• Help educate the public about disaster medical response and preparedness.</li> <li>• Participate in regular training and disaster response related events.</li> <li>• Other related duties as assigned.</li> </ul>				
MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENT				
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rated Emergency Response (ER) personnel are required to be members of the Central Aid Agency in a Rated capacity.</li> </ul>				

<b>FAITH REQUIREMENT</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No specific faith requirement.</li> <li>• Personnel must follow the Code of Conduct.</li> </ul>
<b>HOURS / ACTIVENESS REQUIREMENTS</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Personnel must maintain the minimum activeness standards required by their level of Rating.</li> </ul>
<b>PAYSCALE</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This is a volunteer position</li> </ul>
<b>BENEFITS</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No benefits are currently offered for this position</li> </ul>
<b>HYGIENE AND APPEARANCE REQUIREMENTS</b>
<p>Type 2 (When in full uniform)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Male hair may not be longer than 2 inches from the scalp when in full uniform, must be worn in an authorized professional style, and well groomed.</li> <li>• Facial hair is restricted to a mustache that can extend no further than the corners of the mouth. Sideburns may not extend below the bottom of the ear opening and must have a straight front and bottom edge so that they are rectangular in appearance. The rest of the face must be clean shaven when in full uniform.</li> <li>• Exemptions to this rule may be authorized on a limited basis for specific purposes or field environments, citing necessary medical, security, or operational reasons.</li> <li>• Female hair may be of any length, but may have to be worn up in a military bun, or other authorized hair style, in some instances for safety reasons if it is longer than shoulder length.</li> <li>• Hair color must be a natural looking if colored; off color highlights are not permitted without specific authorization. Corn rows and partially shaved hairstyles must be uniform in appearance and professional looking; and must not interfere with proper equipment fit. Dreadlocks, matted, or unkempt hair is not permitted without specific authorization. Hair must be clean and well maintained.</li> <li>• Tattoos are not restricted below the neckline or above the wrists, but placement on the hands, neck, or face is not permitted. Pre-existing tattoos in these locations require special authorization. One band tattoo is authorized on the ring finger of the left or right hand between the knuckle and first joint, as long as it is ½ inch or less wide. Visible tattoos may be required to be covered while in full uniform.</li> <li>• Piercings are not permitted if they are impractical or leave obvious marks when not worn. Piercings that cannot be removed, gouges, gauges, or bodily disfigurement is not permitted. Only small stud type ear piercings with dull backings should be worn on duty for safety reasons. All piercings may be required to be removed for safety or security reasons while on duty.</li> <li>• Personnel must keep good personal hygiene.</li> </ul>

<b>UNIFORM</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Med Corps personnel typically wear full uniforms (Class C or greater)</li> <li>• Med Corps personnel assigned to an Emergency Response Force unit will typically wear the same uniform as the rest of the unit.</li> <li>• Med Corps personnel are identified by a medical arm band worn on their uniform.</li> </ul>
<b>EQUIPMENT</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Equipment personally purchased by personnel is their property and they may keep it upon leaving the agency.</li> <li>• All other equipment is issued to personnel and must be returned upon leaving the agency.</li> </ul>
<b>DESCRIPTION OF SELECTION PROCESS</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Application Submission</li> <li>• Approval by Med Corps or ERF Officer</li> <li>• Assignment to an Med Corps unit within Emergency Response Force 1.</li> <li>• Issued Red T-shirt and Response Gear</li> <li>• Complete ICS 100, 200, and 700 Certifications</li> <li>• Complete ham radio certification (recommended)</li> <li>• Attend and pass Basic CERT training</li> <li>• Receive full uniform, CERT Tab, and Deployable Status</li> <li>• Personnel will be on probation for up to six (6) months after initial assignment.</li> </ul>
<b>ELIGIBILITY</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>This role is open to Rated personnel.</b></li> <li>• Med Corps is open to all, no prior experience required.</li> </ul> <p><b>CERTIFICATIONS:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must get or maintain proper medical certification (If not already certified).</li> <li>• Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) is the lowest certification level accepted for this position.</li> <li>• Must complete Basic CERT Training within one year of joining the program.</li> <li>• Must complete ICS 100, 200, and 700 within 3 months of Basic CERT Training.</li> <li>• Ham radio certification (Technician or above) is strongly recommended. RRT personnel who are or become ham radio certified will be issued a radio and given preference for promotion and special assignments.</li> <li>• <b>FOR EMS CERTIFICATION HOLDERS (EMR AND ABOVE):</b> National certification through NREMT is required for this position, state level certification is not enough. If currently only state certified, you will need to apply for and receive national certification.</li> <li>• <b>Please list any current or recently expired medical provider certifications, the certification number, and the date of expiration in the space below (attach more pages if needed):</b></li> </ul>
